UNIVERSAL CREDIT



UC payment dates

According to the DWP website those who get their UC on the 25th, 28th can expect payment on 24th and 1st and 4th of January can expect payments on 31st.

Receipiants should check the payment has gone into their account on the 24th, while DWP staff are still available to help.

Guidance about PAYE early payments

If you do get paid early over the Christmas period, please ask your employer to report your normal payday as the payment date on your Full Payment Submission (FPS) and ensure that it is submitted on or before this date.

This helps protect your eligibility for universal credit.

Winter Fuel Payment

The Winter Fuel payment is available to anyone born on or before April 5th 1954 and could mean that they get between £100 and £300 to help pay heating bills.

Winter Fuel payments are made automatically between November and December. If eligible you should get your money by mid January, 2021.

If you are on Universal Credit you might be eligible for such a payment but you will have to contact the DWP to see if you can claim as this is not automatic.

Warm home discount scheme

Did you know you could get up to £140 off your electricity bill under the Warm Home Discount scheme?

The money is paid via a one off discount on your electricity bill between September and March.

You will qualify for this discount if you get the Guarantee Credit element of Pension Credit or meet your suppliers criteria for this scheme.

Cold Weather Payment

If you are receiving one of the DWP credits you may be eligible for Cold Weather Payment - paid when the average temperature in your area is less than zero for seven consecutive days.

Payment is usually automatic and is up to £25 for each seven day period that the bad weather lasts.
