WHERE TO GET FOOD





No one should have to go hungry. If you are worried about how you will manage over the festive season we would urge you to speak to someone about your concerns. Most foodbanks work with local agencies and take referals from them.

Talk to your Housing Officer and they can help you contact the professionals, though some food banks may accept a self referral.

What to expect from a foodbank

If you are referred to the food bank you will get three days worth of nutritionally balanced food and support.

Volunteers will discuss any dietary needs you may have and exchange your foodbank voucher for a parcel of emergency food. They may also help to support you in any other ways in a totally non judgemental way.

However, CFINE will continue emergency home deliveries up until 12pm on 24 December. Deliveries will start again on 29, 30 & 31 December (deliveries on these days will be up to 12pm). Food parcel requests for 29 December must be in by Thursday 24 December (12pm) and requests for January must be in by Thursday 31 December (12pm). Depending on the volume of requests and driver availability, there is no guarantee that parcels will arrive on the day requested. Home deliveries re-start from 5 January.

ASDA

Throughout December, all ASDA supermarket cafes are taking part and will provide children under the age of 16 with a meal completely free of charge when accompanied by an adult. There are no minimum spend requirements or restrictions on the number of children in a family or group that can take advantage of this offer.

Free school meals

Vouchers with a value of £30 will be provided for every child who receives Free School Meals on 18 December. £100 COVID Hardship Payment for low-income families

Payments of £100 per child eligible for Free School Meals will be made by bank transfer. Children in P1 to P3, who would be entitled to Free School meals, because of low-income, are also eligible for this benefit. Only families who have submitted a free school meal application by the 18 December will have access to the payment.
