Scotland's Domestic Abuse and Forced Marriage Helpline

Our 24/7 Helpline is here to give initial support and information to anyone with experience of domestic abuse or forced marriage, as well as their family members, friends, colleagues, and professionals who support them. We provide a confidential, sensitive service to anyone who calls us. Our contact details are in our signature below. If someone requires to speak to us in a language other than English, we use a confidential translation service.

Local Women's Aid groups specialise in supporting women and children affected by domestic abuse, with emotional and practical support that is free, confidential, and non-judgemental. It is possible that they can offer support while a woman is still living with or in a relationship with an abusive partner.

Your local service is Grampian Women's Aid. They are available Wednesdays 9:30am-12:30pm, and other weekdays 9:30am-4pm (closed for lunch between 12:30-1:30), on 01224 593381 and at info@grampian-womens-aid.com. A woman can contact Grampian Women's Aid directly, or an involved professional like yourself can make a referral with a woman's consent.

We work in partnership with the Men's Advice Line, who give specialist advice and support for men experiencing domestic abuse. A man, or someone supporting a man, can reach the Men's Advice Line by calling our helpline number, Monday-Friday, 9am–8pm, and selecting option 2 for the men's service.
