## Where to go for food over Christmas

We don't want you to experience hunger. If you are concerned about managing during the winter months, we encourage you to reach out for support. Many food banks collaborate with local agencies and accept referrals through these organisations.

Talk to your Housing Officer and they can help you contact the professionals, though some food banks may accept a self referral.

## What to expect from a foodbank

If you are referred to a food bank, you will typically receive a three-day supply of food and additional support.

Foodbank volunteers will discuss any dietary requirements you may have and will exchange your food bank voucher for an emergency food parcel. They are also available to offer further assistance in a completely supportive and non-judgmental manner.



## OVERVIEW:

The current crisis in cost of living means that more people than ever are expected to need the services of local food banks this winter.

Local food banks may be able to provide much-needed necessities. It helps if you know how to access them and where the nearest banks are.
